



Road Course Racing Flags

 CHECKERED FLAG	<p>The race has ended. Shown first to the winner, and then to every car to cross the line behind them.</p>
 RED FLAG	<p>Come to safe, controlled stop on either side of the track. Indicates an emergency situation & safety vehicles need to pass. Stay in car completely belted in, with gear & helmet on.</p>
 YELLOW FLAG	<p>Indicates danger ahead and passing is prohibited. A “standing” yellow flag = 70% of race speed; a “waving” yellow flag means = 40% of race speed.</p>
 PASSING FLAG	<p>There is a race going on, and you’re not in it ☺ Indicates that you are about to be passed. HOLD YOUR LINE; don’t not move over!</p>
 BLACK FLAG	<p>Furled black flag is a warning-only. Full black flag means the car needs come off track at next opportunity; usually a driver issue. Must proceed to Black Flag Steward for details.</p>
 DEBRIS FLAG	<p>This is an information flag only notifying drivers there is something on the track (not on the race line), such as debris or fluids. Usually held out for a few laps. Just be aware.</p>
 GREEN FLAG	<p>Race has started! Or a hazard has been cleared up and cars are returned to racing after Yellow flag.</p>
 “MEATBALL” or MECHANICAL FLAG	<p>There is something wrong with your car; driver needs come off track at next opportunity and proceed to Black Flag Steward for details.</p>
 WHITE FLAG	<p>Warns of a slow-moving vehicle on the track, such as a tow truck, safety team or pace car.</p>
