MUFFLERS, MUFFLERS, PLEASE!** The County assigns two sound monitors, located at the hill between Turns 5 and 6. They give teams **one (1) chance to correct any sound issues** and then they put the car on the trailer (no refunds). And there is nothing the Lucky Dog staff will be able to do about it ☹️

PLEASE NOTE: Another group has the track rented for the day (Motor Trend) and we are unable to access the paddock for set-up, Tech & Registration until 6:00pm. Teams arriving early may queue in the Lakebed Parking Lot area until the paddock has been officially turned over to Lucky Dog by the track management; see Track Facility Map on last page. **AND NOTE THAT LUCKY DOG STAFF WILL NOT BE ON PROPERTY UNTIL 3:00pm'ish; please stay out of the doghouse with the track in our absence** 😊

Tech & Safety Inspection and Registration will be conducted in the paddock area. When the track and garages are turned over to Lucky Dog, our staff will provide pit lane and garage assignments...don't not just stake out a garage or pit lane on your own. It's our intent to place garage rental teams in the adjacent pit lane spots, and paddock area.

7/11/18 GARAGE RENTER UPDATE: Please be advised that move-in to the garages will be delayed slightly due to Motor Trend finishing up their filming. We need to remain out of the garages until that time (keeping it quiet & doors closed), which is estimated to be between 6:30pm-7:00pm. You will be able to set-up your pit lane stall and your paddock space and put your car through Tech & Reg during this time. **GARAGE LIST ON LAST PAGE.**

Thursday Night Paddock Access & Camping

We typically don't have access to the paddock or camping on Thursday night (track charges an add'l \$2,500 per night); but we're taking a leap of faith that all teams are willing to **chip in \$50 per team** so that you all can set-up your garages, pit lanes, paddock space and get settled in the night before the event. This "access fee" can be paid for during online Raceday registration or at Tech & Registration. There is also a gorgeous county park camping adjacent to the track is available in the Chaparral and Can-Am Circle "C" Campgrounds for \$35 per night (see map on final page of this document). Liability Waivers:	All people (drivers, guests, etc.) on property must sign the track liability form.
After-Hours Track Access:	Lucky Dog is paying for overnight security on both Thursday & Friday nights so that teams will have 24-hour in/out paddock access.
Pit Lane/Paddock Spots:	PIT STALLS WILL BE ASSIGNED AND WILL POSSIBLY BE SHARED, depending upon the final size of the field. <u>Requests to share a pit lane or be near a team must be sent to info@RaceLucky.com no later than July 1, 2018.</u> Please be considerate of a team's pit lane stall & paddock spot that might be adjacent to their rented garage. And keep in mind we not be able to accommodate everyone's to be near a team as space is limited at the garage end of pit lane. Teams will receive an assigned pit lane map upon track arrival on Thursday as you entire paddock!
Garages:	Garage rentals are sold out & will be assigned on Thursday July 12th.
Volunteers:	We'd love to have you! Come out and earn \$100 per day in race entry credits and a free Lucky Dog shirt. We'll put you to work as a Pit Marshal, professionally outfitted with a track radio and a sexy green safety vest, properly feed and watered for the weekend. Click here for an overview of duties. - Spectators & Fan Club:** FREE, no pit pass or gate fee
- Live Timing/Streaming:** Will be available from the Lucky Dog website at www.RaceLucky.com or via a mobile device via Race Monitor and RaceHero apps. Also follow the race & teams LIVE on YouTube and RaceCapture/Podium. **If you are a team who plans to broadcast live, please let us know at info@RaceLucky.com so that we can help promote your team!**
- Pets:** Are allowed but must be on leash at all times; **but no dogs on pit lane!**
- Children:** Children are welcome in the paddock, **but need to be at least 18 years old to be on the hot and cold pit lane.**
- Fuel:** Yes, the track has 91 octane fuel for sale for \$\$\$ (self-service with a credit card at the pump located in the paddock). No fuel storage in garages.
- Alcohol:** Not allowed during the race/hot track. And no glass allowed!
- Smoking:** NO SMOKING ON PIT LANE...EVER...or near fuel storage in the paddock.
- Camping:** Paddock camping will be available on a first come, first serve basis on Thursday & Friday for \$50 for the weekend per RV/Camper/Trailer that you are sleeping in (note there are no hook-ups or services, and power cords may not be strung through the paddock from the garages or any track buildings). This is in addition to the \$50 Thursday "access fee" by each team as discussed on page 2. There will be 24-hour security so that you'll have in/out paddock access. There is no Saturday night camping in the paddock; we must vacate by 6:00pm. There is also gorgeous county park camping adjacent to the track is available to teams in the Chaparral and Can-Am Circle "C" Campgrounds for \$35 per night (see map on last pages of this document). - BBQs:** BBQs are allowed in the paddock area provided they are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 20' of the open flame and are located at least 30' from race cars & fuel sources.
- Pit Vehicles:** Pit vehicles are allowed in the paddock (but not anywhere else on track or off pavement), and must obey the 10 mph paddock speed limit. No one under 16 allowed on any ATV, golf cart, motorized bike, scooter or skateboards. Helmets required!
- Track Walk:** People may walk or ride a bicycle on the track after hours on Friday with permission from track management (but it will be dark). Nothing motorized; no scooters, golf cars, race cars, passenger vehicles or skateboards.
- Drones:** At no time during the entire weekend (hot track or not), are drones of any sort allowed to be flown at the track (per track & insurance regulations).

Area Hotels: Given this is a resort/vacation destination all year long, we recommend that you book hotel rooms ASAP. The Lucky Dog staff will be staying at the following hotels; decent price with AAA discount & not too far from the track (8 miles/15 minutes). There are a number of hotels on Fremont Avenue area that are responsibility priced and can accommodate trailers, which can be an issue in this town.
