Format: Double 7-Hour Enduros PLUS Evening Sprint Race on Saturday;

JUST ADDED; AN EXTRA HOUR OF RACING ON SUNDAY! Plus Qualifying/Practice Session on Saturday morning) **NO CONTACT SERIES** Saturday sprint race only; \$100 + transponder & camping, see scoop below. While it's not a full moon, there will be 91.2% moon illumination for this event!

Entry Fee: \$300* for Car Entry (includes Captain's driver fee) plus \$300* per driver. Minimum

number of drivers is three (3) or \$900 total entry fee with no less than 2 drivers.

The Gresham Police Department has the track & North Paddock rented on Friday night until 1:00am; we will not be able to do paddock move-in until early Saturday morning via **the Turn 8 Back Gate** (and the South Paddock/Front Gate is being re-paved). However, we will conduct Tech & Registration on Friday in the South Broadacre area outside of the track on Friday, October 26th early evening from **4:00pm – 7:00pm**. Teams are invited to camp in the South Broadacre for free (and Lucky Dog will rent a couple Porta-Potties).

And we will do paddock move-in on Saturday morning between **7:00am-9:00am**. WE NEED TEAMS TO COMPLETE TECH & REG ON FRIDAY NIGHT; PLEASE NO CHECK-IN ON SATURDAY MORNING. Any questions should be directed to Lucky Dog

11:00am 6:00pm **GREEN FLAG!!** Official race start is 11:00am regardless of when flag is actually dropped **CHECKER FLAG!!** Official race end is 6:00pm regardless of stoppages during the day; sunset is 6:05pm. While headlights are NOT required for this enduro, they will be for the exhibition night sprint...and are encouraged in inclement weather.

NEW OPTIONAL LUCKY DOG NIGHT SPRINT RACE! For those that have been begging for some nighttime racing, now's your chance! Racecar classes from Saturday's enduro will remain in place for this sprint exhibition event. This race is optional; your team is not required to run this event but those teams that win 1st place for their class will receive \$100 hard cold cash! Super Dawgs are invited to participate but there is no cash prize. RULES: MUST BE ONE (1) three-minute DRIVER CHANGE DURING SPRINT RACE, any time, your choosing. If you only have one driver, 3 minute pit stop still applies.

Teams that wish to <u>only enter the Exhibition Sprint Race</u> (and not the weekend enduros) will **1)** be required to pay a \$100 entry fee; register online rent transponder, and pay overnight camping as required, **2)** must Tech & Reg on Friday October 26th between 4:00pm-7:00pm, **3)** enter the track prior to Saturday prior to the 9:00am start (or between 9:45am-9:55am), or at 6:00pm sharp for a 6:15pm green flag start.

OTHER EVENT DETAILS

Track Access: REMINDER THAT THIS TRACK HAS AN INTERIOR PADDOCK AREA THAT IS

NOT ACCESIBLE BY VEHICLE FROM THE OUTSIDE DURING THE RACE (i.e., while the track is hot). It is advisable that all teams park a service car outside the paddock near the footbridge, for all fuel runs*, off-track services, parts & supply needs. *IMPORTANT: If you are carrying fuel jugs across the

bridge, you must be accompanied by a team mate with a fire extinguisher.

Pit Lane/Paddock: Due to potential field size, pit stalls may be assigned or even shared like we did for the

July PIR race. Should that be the case again, teams will be notified in advance and pit stall sharing requests will be accepted. As for paddock spots which are not assigned; please be considerate of a team's paddock spot adjacent to their pit lanes. REMEMBER THAT THE PADDOCK IS ONE DIRECTION TRAFFIC; COUNTER CLOCKWISE.

Pit Lane speed is 25 MPH, 2nd gear or 2000 RPMs. **Paddock speed is 10 MPH**. Speeding in either will result in a trip to the Dog House for a meeting with Bulldog.

Liability Waivers: All people (drivers, guests, etc.) on property must sign the track liability form.

Volunteers: We'd love to have you. Come out and earn \$100 per day in race entry credits. Plus, we

feed & water you for the weekend and you can join us for Saturday's BBQ party & raffle

Spectators & Fan Club: FREE, no pit pass or gate fee

Pets: Are allowed but must be on leash at all times

Children: Must be 18 to be over the pit wall (i.e., hot pit lane), and must be 12 to be in the cold pit

lane (cold side of the wall). Please keep an eye on kids at all times since the paddock

area is considered "hot" and there is a lots of car traffic.

Concessions: The Motocross Café will be open on Saturday & Sunday for breakfast & lunch, until 2pm.

Fuel: Fuel will NOT be available at the track, so plan ahead. If you are carrying fuel jugs

across the bridge at any time, you must have someone with a fire extinguisher accompany you OR YOU COULD RECEIVE A RACE PENATLY. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Alcohol: Not allowed during the race/hot track. Technically alcohol is not allowed at PIR as a city-

owned park; be responsible.

Smoking: NO SMOKING ON PIT LANE...EVER. Or near fuel storage in the paddock.

BBQs: BBQs are allowed in the paddock area provided they are supervised at all times, a fire

extinguisher is within 20' of the open flame and are located at least 30' from race cars &

uel sources.

Camping: Overnight camping on Friday is allowed outside the track in the South Broadacre area for

free. Saturday night paddock camping is allowed and can be purchased for \$50 during online Lucky Dog registration or when you get to the track for Friday's Tech & Reg at the Front Gate.

Questions on this should be directed to Lucky Dog and **NOT** the track, thank you!

Paddock camping is first-come, first-serve. Self-contained RV camping (i.e., no hook-ups) in the paddock is allowed on Saturday after we gain entrance to the track. Tent camping is also okay. All teams must vacate the race facility by Sunday evening at 6:00pm.

Pit Vehicles: Pit vehicles are allowed in the paddock (but not anywhere else on track or off pavement),

and must obey the 10 mph paddock speed limit. No one under 16 allowed on any ATV, golf cart, motorized bike, scooters, etc. And skateboards are not allowed...period. <u>Remember</u> that the paddock is one direction traffic; counter clockwise. And because this is a City park,

helmet laws are enforced.

Drones: At no time during the entire weekend (hot track or not), are drones allowed at the track.


