INSTRUCTIONS:

Only those teams that are participating in the track-hosted open practice day (see above) are allowed to enter the track at 7:00am on Friday. ALL OTHERS, i.e., non-track practice teams, are not allowed to enter the track BEFORE 4:00PM. NO EXCEPTIONS. Arrive early and it's recommended that you hang out at the nearby Willows Walmart

Supercenter lot or go grab a bite at Casa Ramos; yep, it's open again!

OVERNIGHT TRACK ACCESS: No In/Out Gate access after midnight on Friday & Saturday nights.

Track-Hosted Open Practice Day* Friday, December 7th:

> 7:00am Gates open for Track Practice teams; all others can't enter until 4:00pm (see above).

> > NO EARLY BIRD ARRIVALS OR ENTRY before Friday morning.

Due to the size of the field, we will NOT be using pit lane nor stall assignments; rather pitting in the paddock (like we have done successfully at Pacific Raceways & Lemons does all the time at most tracks, including Thunderhill). PADDOCK SPACES WILL NOT BE ASSIGNED; FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVE...yep, folks that are participating in Friday's track day will have first-pick of the litter. And for those teams that chose to set-up in a Covered Canopy, they are agreeing to donate \$100 to the event charity which will be for Paradise fire victims; pay at Registration for your Canopy Permit. And don't forget to obey fire lanes, or risk being moved.



10:00am GREEN FLAG!! Official race start is 10:00am regardless of when flag is actually dropped **4:30pm Pit Lane Closes; if you come in after 4:30pm, you're staying.** *More on Parc Fermé*

5:00pm BLACK FLAG ALL/ Parc Fermé/Cars Parks on Pit Lane Track Wall in Position!!

Race ends at 5:00pm regardless of stoppages during the day; sunset is 4:45pm. While headlights are NOT required for this enduro, they are encouraged, especially for inclement weather. Add'l guidance regarding Parc Fermé (i.e., choosing to work on your car overnight vs. staying in position for Sunday's restart) further explained in detail

below.

Parc Fermé Explained:

Parc fermé, literally meaning "closed park" in French, is how Lucky Dog manages a two-day cumulative race during a championship. Pit lane will close 30 minutes before Saturday's "black-flag all" checkered flag at 4:30pm. If you're already in the pits/paddock, or need to pit after that point, you will start 15 minutes after the green flag on Sunday. When the race ends at 5:00pm Saturday, teams still on-track will park their car on the front straight track wall adjacent to the track on pit lane...BUT NOT IN YOUR PIT/PADDOCK STALL. At this point, all cars are parc fermé and cannot be touched or worked on for any reason including tire temps/pressure, cleaning windows/mirrors/lights, cool shirt system servicing, GoPro adjustments, etc....don't even look at your car!

If you have chosen to Parc fermé, you cannot work on your car or fuel on Sunday until you have resumed racing and have taken <u>at least one green flag lap</u>, and then returned to your pit/paddock stall. If you have chosen to come into the pits/paddock on Saturday night to work on your car, you will be able to start Sunday's race after 15-minutes of green flag racing by your competitors.

If your car becomes disabled on track in the last 30 minutes of Saturday's race and you are towed in, you may work on the car overnight and rejoin with the rest of pit lane 15 minutes after green flag Sunday morning. If your car will not start Sunday morning on track, you will be towed in and can start racing 15 minutes after the green flag, provided you can fix it that fast.

When setting up your paddock space please be considerate of excessive use of RV awnings & canopies...we need to accommodate everyone. Extra passenger cars, guest rigs, trailers, transport vehicles, etc. need to be parked outside of the immediate paddock area as directed by the track management.

Pit Lane/Paddock Speeds: Pit Lane speed is 25 MPH, 2nd gear or 2000 RPMs. Paddock speed is 10 MPH.

Speeding in either will result in a trip to the Dog House for a meeting with Bulldog No race engines can be run before 7:30am or after 6:00pm. Quiet time is from

10:00pm – 7:30am. Please be courteous to your neighbors by not playing loud music

or making loud noises between these hours.

Paddock Canopies: A limited number canopy covers are available in the paddock area. As discussed on

Page 2, DO NOT PARK IN THE SOUTH CANOPY ADJACENT TO THE CLUB HOUSE; this is being used on Friday afternoon for Tech Inspection. Once Tech Inspection is completed at approx. 8:00pm and Lucky Dog staff have vacated the area, these canopies are available to teams on a first-come, first-serve basis. Teams may utilize the NORTH CANOPY ADJACENT TO THE HOT PIT ENTRANCE at any time.

AND FOR ALL CANOPIES, those teams that do utilize a Covered Canopy, they are agreeing to donate \$100 to the event charity which will be for Paradise fire victims; pay

at Registration for your Canopy Permit.

Alcohol: Not allowed during the race/hot track.

Smoking: NO SMOKING ON PIT LANE...EVER. Or near fuel storage in the paddock.

BBQs: BBQs are allowed in the paddock area provided they are supervised at all times, a fire

extinguisher is within 20' of the open flame and are located at least 30' from race cars & fuel sources. No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured

barbeques and grills are permitted. NO SMUDGE POTS...PERIOD!

Pit Vehicles: Pit vehicles are allowed in the paddock (but not anywhere else on track or off pavement),

and must obey the 10 mph paddock speed limit. No one under 16 allowed on any ATV,

golf cart, motorized bike, scooter or skateboards. HELMETS REQUIRED!

Camping: Self-contained RV camping in the paddock is allowed on Friday & Saturday nights; \$50

camping fee per camper/motorhome/trailer used for accommodations (paid online during Registration or at the track on Friday). Restrooms and showers as well as electrical hookups are located in the paddock. No black or gray water dumping. Do not overload electrical hook-ups with excessive cords. Tent camping is also okay. Paddock camping

is first-come, first-serve as outlined on Page 2.

Track Walk: People may walk or ride a bicycle on the track after hours on Friday with permission from

track management. HELMETS REQUIRED! Nothing motorized; no scooters, golf cars,

race cars, passenger vehicles or skateboards.

Drones: During entire weekend (hot track or not), drones of any sort are not allowed to be flown at

the track (per track & insurance regulations).
