PADDOCK MOVE-IN / NO ENTRY TO THE TRACK PRIOR TO 4:00PM

Due to SCCA Track Night in America festivities (4pm-8pm), we will not have full access to cross the track into the North Paddock until they conclude their program around 8pm-9pm (but we can take advantage of intermittent track crossings facilitated by security personnel). After SCCA's program gets started at 4pm, early arriving teams will come through the Main Gate and cross into the North Paddock via the Start/Finish Gate (see map last page). Early arrivals (i.e., before 4pm), please queue in the South Broadacre

area AND DO NOT LINE UP ON BROADACRE ROAD. DO NOT ENTER THROUGH FRONT MAIN GATE DUE TO SCCA EVENING EVENTS until we are instructed to do so by PIR track management.

4:00pm - 8:00pm

TECHNICAL SAFETY INSPECTION & REGISTRATION/TIMING TOWER NORTH PADDOCK*

While we don't have an exact schedule for these intermittent crossings into the North Paddock via the Start/Finish Gate in-between SCCA run programs, we appreciate your patience as everyone works to get you into the paddock quickly. Once teams enter into the paddock, they can complete Tech & Safety Inspection, Registration & Gear Check. Teams will be allowed to enter the North Paddock area for overnight storage of cars/trailers, camping, cold pit lane and paddock set-up. Hot pit lanes cannot be set-up until SCCA's program concludes sometime between 8pm-9pm. More on camping, paddock access permits and set-up below.

NEW POLICY: Due to insurance/liability requirements (plus some recent wristband fraud ③), LDRL will now be personally placing all wristbands on drivers during Registration. Team driver bands will no longer be issued to the team captain; drivers must present themselves with ID to receive their wristband at Registration before getting on-track (any time during the weekend at Race Central/2nd Floor Timing Tower).

NEW POLICY: Two (2) teams will be randomly selected at each Drivers Meeting for roll call to confirm attendance by <u>all</u> of your drivers <u>and</u> team captain (no substitutes/stand-ins). Failure to make roll call will result in an automatic 5-minute start penalty. Any team or driver misrepresenting themselves at roll call will result in automatic expulsion <u>for the team</u> from the race event.

8:50am Cars to Grid on pit lane for memorial lap/qualifying/practice session

OPTIONAL SATURDAY NIGHT SPRINTS (btw, sunset is 9:02pm)

The Utah dawgs had so much fun with the sprint formats LDRL bought out PIR's Saturday night drag racing program so that we could go racing a little later and offer two (2) 45-minute sprints (which are optional). Here are the Sprint Rules:



- Sprints will start under Pace control, double-file rolling start (like our enduros)
- Cars will be lined up & released on track based on Class; A Class lined up against pit wall
 against the track, B Class in middle line and C Class lined up closest to the paddock pit wall.
- During each sprint, two different registered drivers must take a stint (will be verified)
- During each sprint, one (1) minimum 3-minute stop in the pits must be made.
- No taking fuel during each sprint AND no fuel can be taken between Sprints #1 and #2
- Should you take fuel during a sprint or in between both sprints, the car must line up at the end
 of your Class's grid on pit lane.
- Trophies will be awarded for 1st place in each Class (i.e., A/B/C) for both sprints. Car must take the green <u>and</u> checker flag <u>on-track</u> to be eligible for trophies/podium. Yes, there is a story here too ☺



OTHER EVENT DETAILS

Track Access: REMINDER THAT THIS TRACK HAS AN INTERIOR PADDOCK AREA THAT IS NOT

ACCESIBLE BY VEHICLE FROM THE OUTSIDE DURING THE RACE (i.e., while the track is hot). It is advisable that all teams park a service car outside the paddock near the footbridge, for all fuel runs*, off-track services, parts & supply needs. *IMPORTANT: If you are carrying fuel jugs across the bridge, you must be accompanied by a team mate with a fire extinguisher; failure to do so will result in a dog house penalty.

Pit Lane/Paddock Spots: Due to field size, pit stalls will be assigned and possibly shared like past PIR events.

Should you wish to be adjacent to or share a stall with a specific team, please email us at info@RaceLucky.com no later than June 21st (no at-track changes). As for paddock spots which are not assigned; please be considerate of a team's paddock spot adjacent to their pit lanes. REMEMBER THAT THE PADDOCK IS ONE DIRECTION TRAFFIC; COUNTER CLOCKWISE. Paddock speed 10 mph & pit lane speed 25 mph; relentlessly

enforced!

Liability Waivers: All people (drivers, guests, etc.) on property must sign the track liability form.

Headlights: Not required though handy in inclement weather. Sunset is at 9:02pm.

Volunteers: We'd love to have you! Come out and earn \$100 per day in race entry. We'll put you to work as

a Pit Marshal, professionally outfitted with a track radio and a sexy green safety vest, properly feed and watered for the weekend. Click here for an overview of duties. Volunteer @

Spectators & Fan Club: FREE, no pit pass or gate fee

Live Timing/Streaming: Will be available from the Lucky Dog website at www.RaceLucky.com or via a mobile device via

Race Monitor and RaceHero apps. Also follow the race & teams LIVE on YouTube and RaceCapture/Podium. If you are a team who plans to broadcast live, please let us know at

info@RaceLucky.com so that we can help promote your team!

Pets: Are allowed but must be on leash at all times.

Children: Must be 18 to be over the pit wall (i.e., hot pit lane), and must be 12 to be in the cold pit

lane (cold side of the wall). Please keep an eye on kids at all times since the paddock

area is considered "hot" and there is a lots of car traffic.

Concessions: The Motocross Café will be open on Saturday & Sunday for breakfast & lunch, until 2pm.

We'll try to get the cool little coffee truck that we've had in the past for lattes.

Fuel: Fuel will NOT be available at the track, so plan ahead. If you are carrying fuel jugs across

the bridge at any time, you must have someone with a fire extinguisher accompany you

OR YOU COULD RECEIVE A RACE PENATLY, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Alcohol: Not allowed during the race/hot track. Technically alcohol is not allowed at PIR as a city-

owned park; be responsible.

Smoking: NO SMOKING ON PIT LANE...EVER. Or near fuel storage in the paddock.

Camping: Purchase a weekend paddock access permit for \$50 during Friday's Tech & Registration from

Lucky Dog during online registration. Teams/Drivers that purchase Paddock Access
Permits in advance will be placed on a gate list for verification as you enter the track. If
you are not the list, you will need to purchase a permit as you enter the track on Friday
night (cash required; no credit cards). A Paddock Access Permit is required for 1) any
vehicle or trailer that is left in the paddock overnight on Friday, or 2), will be used for
sleeping over the weekend. Paddock camping is first-come, first-serve. Self-contained RV
camping (i.e., no hook-ups) in the paddock is allowed on Friday night after we gain entrance to
the paddock via the Main Gate as outlined above in the move-in guidance. Tent camping is also
allowed. All teams must vacate the race facility by Sunday evening at 6:00pm. LDRL has paid

for 24-hour security this year to support late arrivals & in & out privileges.

BBQs: BBQs are allowed in the paddock area provided they are supervised at all times, a fire

extinguisher is within 20' of the open flame and are located at least 30' from race cars & fuel

sources.

Race Equipment Vendor:

Pit Vehicles: Pit vehicles are allowed in the paddock (but not anywhere else on track or off pavement), and

must obey the 10 mph paddock speed limit. No one under 16 allowed on any ATV, golf cart, motorized bike, scooter or skateboards. And because this is a City park, helmet laws are

enforced. Remember that the paddock is one-direction traffic; counter clockwise.

Drones: At no time during the entire weekend (hot track or not), drones of any sort are not allowed to be

flown at the track...per track policy and LDRL's insurance carrier.

Official Event Hotel: Please be advised that the nearby Day's Inn has now been remodeled and is a Country Inn &

Suites by Carlson property that will serve as the official Lucky Dog event hotel again. We have


