This three-event points championship will begin at the newly paved popular Carolina Motorsports Park (CMP); hosted by <u>Innovation Performance Technologies</u> on February 26-27; 2022, on to Atlanta Motorsports Park, hosted by <u>Discovery Parts</u> on May 21-22, 2022; and return to CMP for the grand finale, hosted by <u>LifelineUSA</u> on September 24-25, 2022 where the Southern Endurance Cup Champion Top Dawgs will be crowned for all three racing classes! *The SEC Points Structure is outlined in detail at the back of this document.* Teams are not required to participate in all three events and may race at single events, but those teams that participate in all three races (with the same car + two original drivers) will be in contention for the Southern Endurance Cup championship.

Liability Waivers: COVID Guidance:

All people (drivers, crew, guests, etc.) on property must sign the track liability form. Spectators, Crew & Guests: Pit Lane/Paddock/Speed:

Like Lucky Dog's 2021 CMP events, CMP's pit lane will be used; stalls will not be assigned but available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Paddock spots are also on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please be very aware of two-way traffic, participants, pets, etc. REMEMBER THAT THE PADDOCK SPEED LIMIT IS 10mph; and pit lane speed is 25 mph. Speed limits will be mercilessly enforced and you may get a trip to the Dog House. Must be 16 years or older to be on hot pit lane.

Fuel: Fuel is available for sale on-site; CMP now carries Sunoco pay-at-the-pump race fuel.

Pets: Are allowed but must be on leash at all times.
