Paddock & Garage Rental Set-up: Track day teams may set-up in their paddock spots adjacent to the pit lane stalls assigned for the weekend. **We will be using the new extended pit lane and assigning stalls (approx. 12' – 13' each, which means no larger than 10x10 canopies).** Pit Lane & Garage "neighbor" requests must be made no later than August 26, 2022 to Registration@RaceLucky.com. Pit lane assignments will be emailed & posted to the website no later than Weds., Sept. 7, 2022. **When setting up your paddock, only one RV, Trailer or Transport Vehicle per team in the Main Paddock A and please minimize the use of RV awnings & canopies... we need to accommodate everyone. Liability Waivers: **All Participants (drivers, crew, guests, staff & volunteers) will sign e-waivers in advance via <https://waiver.fr/p-RwiM5>.**

Paddock & Pit Lane Speed Limits: Please be very aware of two-way traffic, participants, pets, etc. in the paddock where the 10 mph speed limit will be mercilessly enforced and you may get a trip to the Dog House. Pit lane speed is 25 mph.

After-Hours Track Access: Lucky Dog is paying for overnight security on both Friday & Saturday so that teams will have 24-hour in/out paddock access. There is no overnight camping on Thursday or Sunday nights.

Children: Are allowed but must be kept solely within your paddock area or RV/trailer; we can't have them walking around, on bikes in a hot paddock or unattended. You must be 16 years of age to be on hot pit lane and 12 years of age to be in a team's cold pit area.

**** NEW** Pets:** Pets are allowed but a \$25 Pet Permit is now required as pet owners have not been taking care of business per the track. One (1) permit will cover your single/multiple pets; purchase during online LDRL Raceday registration for \$25 or at Race Central. **Per the Ridge Management for the 2021 Season:** Dogs have now become a huge concern. We have had dogs leave their business in places that have us questioning if we should even allow pets on the property any more. A lot of times these bathroom breaks are done right in front of Ridge team members with owners ignoring their messes and just walking off. This is a respect

issue for anyone using the property. We've had pet owners allowing pets to take bathroom breaks in front of the Café doors, on the ADA ramp, hand sanitize stations, and more. The majority of these areas were dog poop and then dogs peeing on hand sanitizer stations. With this, we have implemented a \$500.00 post event cleaning fee per track event. We want to help support the issue and will have doggie stations put in place for owners to clean up after their dogs. As an organization you can decide if you would like to allow pets moving forward on your day. If we keep having issues, we will need to decide if pets are allowed on the property moving into 2022. Lastly, the bigger concern is dogs being on a leash at all times. There have been times where dogs have not been on a leash and have wandered their way towards the track and at times have entered the track. We just ask everyone to be responsible pet owners so we can keep allowing the facility to be a family place for everyone, this includes dogs.

Alcohol/Drugs: Alcohol not allowed during the race/hot track. And no glass allowed in paddock. Recreational drug usage is never allowed at LDRL or track venues regardless of local/state/federal governing laws.

Smoking/Vaping: NO SMOKING/VAPING IN THE PADDOCK...or near fuel storage in the paddock.

Camping: Self-contained RV camping in the paddock is allowed on Friday & Saturday nights; \$50 Paddock Permit fee per camper/motorhome/trailer used for accommodations (paid online during LDRL Raceday Registration). There are no hook-ups. Tent camping is also allowed at no cost. There is no overnight camping on Thursday or Sunday nights.

Food Concessions: The new Ridge Café has updated their menu & food quality, serving up breakfast, coffee and awesome lunches! Opens at 6:30am-11am for breakfast and 11pm-3pm for lunch. It's located on the first floor of the Performance Center and has the single red garage door facing the paddock.

BBQs: BBQs/Grills WITHOUT OPEN FLAMES are allowed in the paddock area provided they are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 20', and are located at least 30' from race cars & fuel sources. **NO OPEN FLAMES/NO SMUDGE POTS**

Pit Vehicles: Pit vehicles are allowed in the paddock (but not anywhere else on track or off pavement), and must obey the 10 mph paddock speed limit. No one under 16 allowed on any ATV, golf cart, motorized bike, scooter or skateboards.

Track Walk: People may walk or ride a bicycle on the track after hours on Friday with permission from track management. Nothing motorized; no scooters, golf cars, race cars, passenger vehicles or skateboards.

Drones: During entire weekend (hot track or not), drones are not allowed to be flown at the track by unauthorized pilots. Please be advised that Lucky Dog has secured a licensed/insured drone pilot to shoot footage of your skillful driving all weekend though!

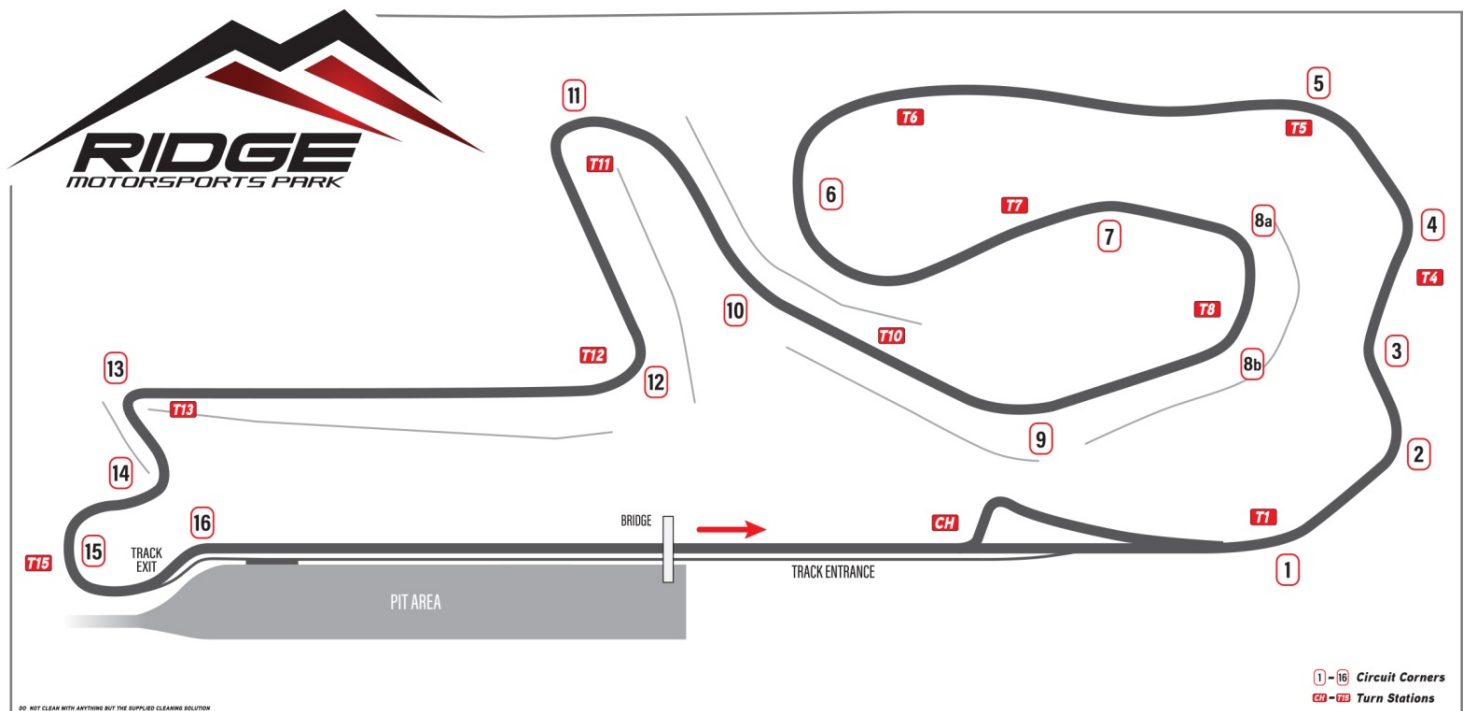
