**Early Queuing til Approx. 4:00pm** Early arriving NON-TRACK DAY Lucky Dog teams please queue in the South Broadacre area AND DO NOT LINE UP ON BROADACRE ROAD or block PIR's Main Front Gate.

**Track Entrance** Teams will enter via PIR's Main Gate, sign a track liability waiver, cross over at the Start/Finish gate into the North Paddock & be allowed overnight storage of cars/trailers, camping, cold pit lane and paddock set-up. **Due to the Friday night drags program, teams are not allowed to set-up hot pit lane until Saturday morning.**

**OVERNIGHT/24-Hour** Track Main Front Gate will be staffed by Security to support late arrivals and in & out privileges.

**PADDOCK PERMIT/Camping:**  
**\*\*ALL TEAMS\*\***

As a City park, and because the track is doing us a favor by allowing us in the night before our event, a Paddock Access Permit is required for 1) any vehicle/trailer/racecar combo or racecar that is left in the paddock overnight on Friday, or 2), vehicle/trailer/RV that will be used for sleeping over the weekend. Purchase a weekend paddock access permit for \$50 from Lucky Dog during online Raceday registration or at Friday's Tech & Registration. Permit must be displayed on your rig or risk getting ticketed. Paddock camping is first-come, first-serve. Self-contained RV camping (i.e., no hook-ups) in the paddock is allowed on Friday night after we gain entrance to the paddock as outlined in the event schedule move-in guidance. Tent camping is also allowed.

## OTHER EVENT DETAILS

**Track Access:** REMINDER THAT THIS TRACK HAS AN INTERIOR PADDOCK AREA THAT IS NOT ACCESSIBLE BY VEHICLE FROM THE OUTSIDE DURING THE RACE (i.e., while the track is hot). It is advisable that all teams park a service car outside the paddock near the footbridge, for all fuel runs\*, off-track services, parts & supply needs. **\*IMPORTANT: If you are carrying fuel jugs across the bridge, you must be accompanied by a team mate with a fire extinguisher; failure to do so will result in a dog house penalty.**

**Pit Lane Stalls/Paddock:** Due to field size, pit stalls will be assigned and possibly shared like past PIR events. Should you wish to be adjacent to or share a stall with a specific team, please email us at [info@RaceLucky.com](mailto:info@RaceLucky.com) no later than **October 15, 2023** (no at-track changes). Pit Lane Assignments will be emailed & posted no later than **Thursday, October 26, 2023**. Please confirm with other team first. As for paddock spots which are not assigned; please be considerate of a team's paddock spot adjacent to their pit lanes (and please minimize the use of awnings/canopies so that everyone fits). REMEMBER THAT THE PADDOCK IS ONE DIRECTION TRAFFIC; COUNTER CLOCKWISE. Paddock speed 10 mph & pit lane speed 25 mph; relentlessly enforced!

**Liability Waivers:** All people (drivers, guests, etc.) on property must sign the track liability form.  
**Headlights:** Not required though handy in inclement weather. Sunset is at 6:04pm PDT.  
**Volunteers:** We'd love to have you! Volunteer at [info@RaceLucky.com](mailto:info@RaceLucky.com) and earn race entry credits! Come out and earn \$100 per day in race entry credits (or choose overnight housing; space permitting, double occupancy & 30 days advance notice). We'll put you to work as a Pit Marshal, professionally outfitted with a track radio and a sexy green safety vest, properly feed and watered for the weekend. **FOR FULL SCOOP, QUESTIONS AND TO VOLUNTEER, CLICK HERE.** WE HAVE A NEW FUELING SAFETY VIDEO; please take a couple of minutes to review it at <http://luckyfuel.net/>.

**Live Timing/Streaming:** Will be available from the Lucky Dog website at [www.RaceLucky.com](http://www.RaceLucky.com) or via a mobile device via Race Monitor and RaceHero apps. Also follow the race & teams LIVE on Facebook, YouTube and RaceCapture/Podium. **If you are a team who plans to broadcast live, please let us know at [info@RaceLucky.com](mailto:info@RaceLucky.com) so that we can help promote your team!**

**Pets:** Are allowed but must be on leash at all times.

**Children:** Must be 18 to be over the pit wall (i.e., hot pit lane), and must be 12 to be in the cold pit lane (cold side of the wall). Please keep an eye on kids at all times since the paddock area is considered "hot" and there is a lots of car traffic.

**Concessions:** The Motocross Café will be open on Saturday & Sunday for breakfast & lunch, until 2pm.

**Fuel:** Fuel is not available at the track, so plan ahead. If you are carrying fuel jugs across the bridge at any time, you must have someone with a fire extinguisher accompany you OR YOU COULD RECEIVE A RACE PENALTY, NO EXCEPTIONS.

**Alcohol/Drugs:** Alcohol not allowed during the race/hot track (plus PIR is a City-owned park with a no alcohol policy). And no glass allowed in paddock. Recreational drug usage is never allowed at LDRL or track venues regardless of local/state/federal governing laws.

**Smoking/Vaping:** NO SMOKING/VAPING IN THE PADDOCK...or near fuel storage in the paddock.

**PADDOCK PERMIT/Camping:**

**\*\*ALL TEAMS\*\***

As a City park, and because the track is doing us a favor by allowing us in the night before our event, **a Paddock Access Permit is required for 1) any vehicle/trailer/racecar combo or racecar that is left in the paddock overnight on Friday, or 2), vehicle/trailer/RV that will be used for sleeping over the weekend.** Purchase a weekend paddock access permit for \$50 from Lucky Dog during online Raceday registration or at Friday's Tech & Registration. Permit must be displayed on your rig or risk getting ticketed. Paddock camping is first-come, first-serve. Self-contained RV camping (i.e., no hook-ups) in the paddock is allowed on Friday night after we gain entrance to the paddock as outlined in the event schedule move-in guidance. Tent camping is also allowed. All teams must vacate the race facility by Sunday evening at 7:00pm. **LDRL has paid for 24-hour security this year to support late arrivals & in & out privileges on Friday & Saturday nights.**

**Race Equipment Vendor:** We highly recommend series sponsor Andy Collins from Armadillo Racing who will be at onsite for this event. Contact Andy at [www.ArmadilloRacing.com](http://www.ArmadilloRacing.com) or 888.211.9129.

**Radio Equipment Vendor:** While there will not be an onsite vendor, we highly recommend series sponsor Shawn at [www.SampsonRacing.com](http://www.SampsonRacing.com) or 866.396.7231. Order in advance for shipment. They offer a 15% Lucky Dog discount!

**BBQs:** BBQs are allowed in the paddock area provided they are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 20' of the open flame and are located at least 30' from race cars & fuel sources.

**Pit Vehicles:** Pit vehicles are allowed in the paddock (but not anywhere else on track or off pavement), and must obey the 10 mph paddock speed limit. No one under 16 allowed on any ATV, golf cart, motorized bike, scooter or skateboards. And because this is a City park, helmet laws are enforced. Remember that the paddock is one-direction traffic; counter clockwise.

**Drones:** At no time during the entire weekend (hot track or not), drones of any sort are not allowed to be flown at the track...per track policy and LDRL's insurance carrier (except for FAA-licensed drone pilots who have gained prior track/LDRL approval, like Hayley Mays).

**Weather:** We're racing regardless of weather including track tornados ☺

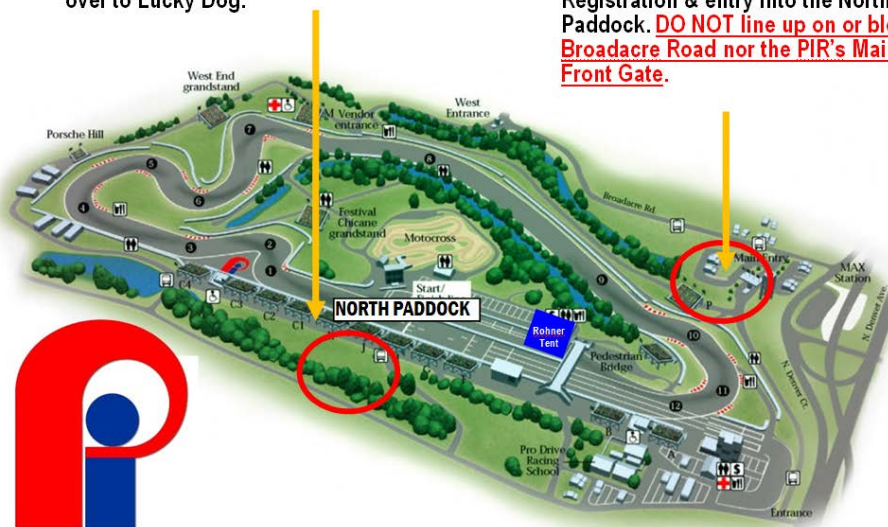
