Paddock & Garage Rental Set-up:

Track day teams may set-up in their paddock spots adjacent to the pit lane stalls assigned for the weekend. We will be using the extended pit lane and assigning stalls (approx. 12' – 13' each, which means no larger than 10x10 canopies). Pit Lane & Garage "neighbor" requests must be made no later than April 15, 2024 to Registration@RaceLucky.com. Pit lane assignments will be emailed & posted to the website no later than Weds., April 17, 2024. When setting up your paddock, only one RV, Trailer or Transport Vehicle per team in the paddock and please minimize the use of RV awnings & canopies... we need to accommodate everyone. If your set-up does not fit in the main Paddock A (i.e., too wide or too long), you can move to the overflow area in Paddock B. Garages are assigned and parking outside the garage bays belongs to renters. ALL extra passenger vehicles, trailers, etc. need to be parked outside of the immediate paddock area as directed by the track management). Bad dawgs disobeying parking rules will



Panels are 13.5"W x 18.5"H; three (3) are required (each door & the roof or hood for convertibles), & numbers are to be in Trade Gothic font (font file is provided for DIY's).

can't have them walking around, on bikes in a hot paddock or unattended. You must be 16 years of age to be on hot pit lane and 12 years of age to be in a

team's cold pit area.

** NEW** Pets: Pets are allowed but a \$25 Pet Permit is now required as pet owners have not

> been taking care of business per the track. One (1) permit will cover your single/multiple pets: purchase during online LDRL Raceday registration for \$25 or at Race Central. Per the Ridge Management: Dogs have now become a huge concern. We have had dogs leave their business in places that have us questioning if we should even allow pets on the property any more. A lot of times these bathroom breaks are done right in front of Ridge team members with owners ignoring their messes and just walking off. This is a respect issue for anyone using the property. We've had pet owners allowing pets to take bathroom breaks in front of the Café doors, on the ADA ramp, hand sanitize stations, and more. The majority of these areas were dog poop and then dogs peeing on hand sanitizer stations. With this, we have implemented a \$500.00 post event cleaning fee per track event. We want to help support the issue and will have doggie stations put in place for owners to clean up after their dogs. As an organization you can decide if you would like to allow pets moving forward on your day. If we keep having issues, we will need to decide if pets are allowed on the property moving into 2022. Lastly, the bigger concern is dogs being on a leash at all times. There have been times where dogs have not been on a leash and have wondered

family place for everyone, this includes dogs.

Alcohol not allowed during the race/hot track. And no glass allowed in paddock. Alcohol/Drugs:

Recreational drug usage is never allowed at LDRL or track venues regardless of

nights; \$50 Paddock Permit fee per camper/motorhome/trailer used for

accommodations (paid online during LDRL Raceday Registration). There are no hook-ups. Tent camping is also allowed. There is no overnight camping on

Thursday or Sunday nights.

Food Concessions: The Ridge Café will be serving up breakfast, coffee and awesome lunches!

Opens at 6:30am-11am for breakfast and 11pm-3pm for lunch. It's located on the first floor of the Performance Center and has the single red garage door facing the

paddock.

BBQs: BBQs/Grills WITHOUT OPEN FLAMES are allowed in the paddock area provided

they are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 20', and are located at least 30' from race cars & fuel sources. NO OPEN FLAMES/NO SMUDGE POTS

Pit Vehicles: Pit vehicles are allowed in the paddock (but not anywhere else on track or off

pavement), and must obey the 10 mph paddock speed limit. No one under 16 allowed on any ATV, golf cart, motorized bike, scooter or skateboards. **HELMETS**

REQUIRED!

Track Walk: People may walk or ride a bicycle on the track after hours on Friday with

permission from track management. Nothing motorized; no scooters, golf cars,

race cars, passenger vehicles or skateboards.


