## EVENT SCHEDULE



### \*NEW\* HEAT ADVISORY & DRIVER STINT LENGTH:

- 1) Given that it appears we will be experience very hot weather in the high 90s, **we will be going to one (1) hour driver stints as a safety precaution (and not our normal 2 hour stints), which worked well at Rockingham last June as well as last week in Oregon.** However, 1) all cars must still come in for 5-minutes every two (2) hours; and 2) all fueling stops will still be 5-minutes. Driver changes only are not limited to 5 minutes unless you are serving your mandatory 5-minute stop every two (2) hours.

### REMINDERS for Track Damage, Health Insurance & Medical Transport:

- 2) Teams are personally responsible financially for any damage to Lucky Dog or racetrack property and assets that is caused directly or indirectly by your drivers/crew/guests.
- 3) All Drivers must have personal medical insurance in effect and Lucky Dog Enterprises LLC and Lucky Dog Racing League Racing is in no way responsible for any loss, injury or damage you sustain in the course of participating, driving, or attending one of our events.
- 4) If your drivers, crew, family or guests have a medical transport, VIR does charge a Ground Transport Fee that your team will be responsible for.

### VIR TRACK REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) **VIR does not allow two-piece fire suits; all suits over the pit wall must be single piece fire suits.**
- 2) VIR discourages bringing pets to the track. If pets are brought to the track, they must be on a leash at all times, controlled by the Owner/Handler. The Owner/Handler is responsible for providing their own waste-handling supplies and for cleaning up behind the pet at ALL times. Pets are not permitted in the False Grid, Pit Road, Restricted Areas, or any of VIR's buildings, concessions, or lodging facilities. Please do not leave pets in vehicles unattended. Service Animals are permitted in accordance with the ADA Disabilities Act.
- 3) Kids must be 18 & older to be on cold OR hot pit lane.

# RACE INFORMATION & REGISTRATION

- Format:** 7 + 8 Hours (plus Friday 90-minute practice/qualifying session); Two (2) separate races; trophies each day. Full Course (3.27 miles)! There no track practice day on Thursday.
- Entry Fee:** Car Entry (includes Captain): EARLY DOG DISCOUNT \$500 USD plus \$500 per add'l driver. Event requires minimum four (4) driver entry fees (or \$2000 team entry fee with no less than 2 actual drivers). Register online at [www.RaceLucky.com](http://www.RaceLucky.com) (online registration closes June 20, 2025; all other changes/additions can be handled at the track).
- \*Payment Deadlines:** Early Dog Discount \$500 thru May 27, 2025; after that Regular Registration Fee is \$550 per driver.
- Licensing:** FREE membership! NO licensing requirements or license fees!
- Crew/Guest/Spectator Fees:** Lucky Dog never charges a fee or pit pass for crew, guests, family or your fan club.
- Minor Drivers:** If a minor driver (less than 18 years old) is registered for this event, please contact [cathy@RaceLucky.com](mailto:cathy@RaceLucky.com) ASAP as our insurance company has to approve and provide a special policy to the track; **must be requested no later than June 10, 2025**
- Transponders:** Required. You can rent one from us for \$50 **Rental Deadline is June 10, 2025.** **\*\*NEW\*\* Lucky Dog also has a discounted transponder program that allows you to have your own unit, [click here](#).**

- Headlights:** Not required but recommended in inclement weather. Sunset 8:38pm
- Code 35 Flagging:** For the second time, Lucky Dog will be using Code 35 flagging protocol for this race. Double yellow flags will be used instead of a pace car for all track recovery requirements. Drivers are asked to reduce speed to 35 mph, and maintain the distance between you and the racecar in front of you; NO PASSING UNDER YELLOW. *More details included below.*
- Sound:** Max sound of 96dba at 50-feet from any track edge will be enforced. All racecars are required to have mufflers.
- Quiet Hours:** Quiet hours for the entire VIR Property are from 11:00pm. to 7:00am. This includes all lodging, camping, and Industrial areas. VIR asks that all guests be considerate of others and not play loud music. Any music that is determined to be a nuisance by VIR Security must be turned down or off. Unmuffled engines (vehicles) must not be run between 8:00pm and 8:00am.
- Children/Bikes/Etc.:** Reminder that you must be 18 years or older to be on pit lane (**hot or cold pit lane**). Children under 18 years of age are to be supervised by a Parent, Guardian, or Responsible Adult and must be present to sign the minor waiver to enter. Children are not permitted to ride bikes, rollerblades, skates, or scooters in the Paddock during hot track hours. Children may be permitted to ride them at the end of the day if they do so safely. **Hoverboards, skateboards, scooters without seats or single-wheeled vehicles are not permitted for use at VIR at any time.**
- Pets:** **VIR discourages bringing pets to the track.** If pets are brought to the track, they must be on a leash at all times, controlled by the Owner/Handler. The Owner/Handler is responsible for providing their own waste-handling supplies and for cleaning up behind the pet at ALL times. Owners/Handlers who do not comply with this policy may be removed from the premises. Pets are not permitted in the False Grid, Pit Road, Restricted Areas, or any of VIR's buildings, concessions, or lodging facilities. Please do not leave pets in vehicles unattended. Service Animals are permitted in accordance with ADA

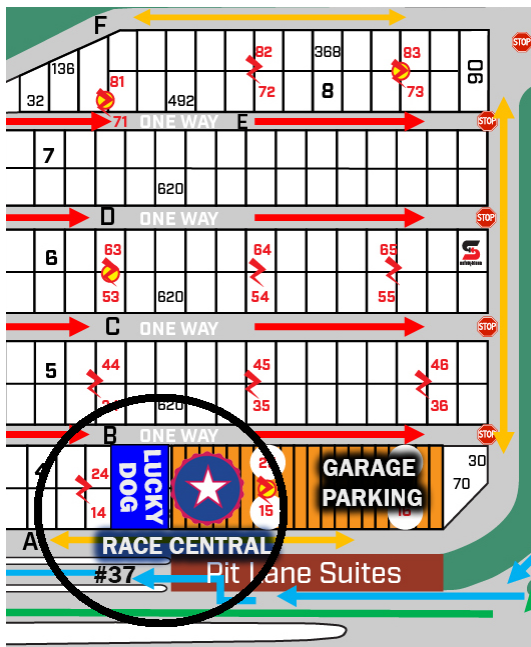

**6:30pm – 8:00pm: COLD PIT LANE SET-UP (NO RACECARS, NOTHING MOTORIZED)**

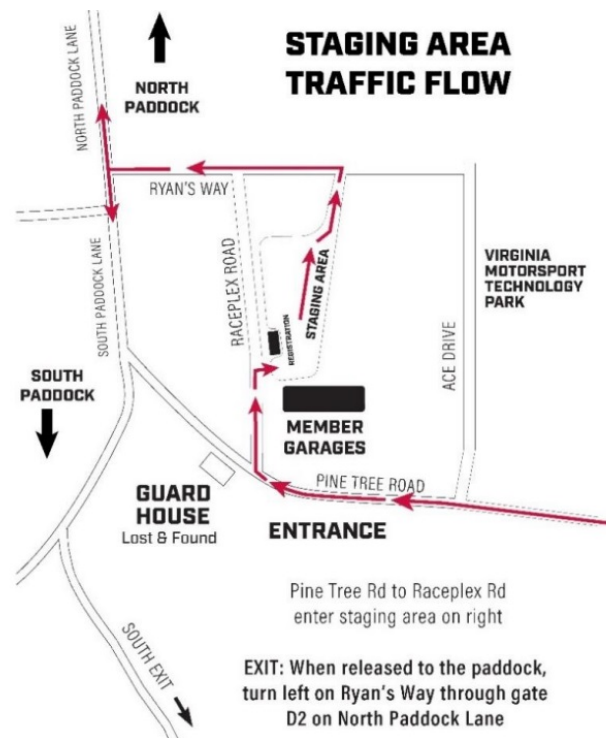

## OTHER EVENT DETAILS

### Other VIR Policies:

VIR has additional policies that may not be covered in this event schedule; please review <https://virnow.com/about/policies/>. VIR SECURITY STAFF WILL BE IN THE PADDOCK ALL WEEKEND TO ENFORCE POLICIES.

### Paddock/Pit Lane Speeds:

The paddock is considered a live racetrack and as such, non-racing vehicles must provide the right away to all racecars at all times. Paddock speed is max 10 mph and strongly enforced. Pit lane max speed is 20 mph.

### Tow Eyes:

It is strongly recommended (and required for non-street-legal cars) that all vehicles have at least two (2) easily accessible and usable tow eyes on the front and rear of the car. They must not protrude dangerously from the car, and they must be accessible without manipulation of the bodywork or panels. They must be strong enough to support the weight of the car. If no tow eyes are available, the towing crew will hook onto other areas that may cause damage to the car. Neither the towing crew nor VIR is responsible or liable for that damage.

### Fire Lanes:

Fire Lanes in each Paddock (outlined in yellow) must remain clear at all times. This includes in front of Victory Lane and the "No Parking" lane in front of the Pagoda in the North Paddock and South Paddock Timing Tower.

### CODE 35 PROCEDURES:

When Race Control needs to dispatch Emergency Vehicles (EV), drivers will see all corner stations display a Yellow Flag and a Purple Flag with a white number '35' on it. The 'Code 35' flag may be used in lieu of putting out a safety car and allow EV to rapidly respond.



### DRIVERS MUST:

STOP RACING.

NOT PASS OTHER CARS ON TRACK.

SAFELY REDUCE THEIR SPEED NOT TO EXCEED 35 MPH.

MAINTAIN THEIR SEPARATION FROM THE CAR IN FRONT OF THEM. FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF THE CORNER MARSHALS.

YIELD THE RACING SURFACE TO ALL EMERGENCY VEHICLES.

**RESTARTS:** At the conclusion of a 'Code 35' incident and to resume racing, drivers will see the Yellow and Purple '35' Flags replaced with a Waiving Green Flag at all stations.

**SPEEDING PENALTIES:** All lap times during a Code 35 incident will be recorded by Timing & Scoring. Teams exceeding the required 35 MPH limit will receive a Black Flag and a Speeding Penalty after racing has resumed. Drivers who do not maintain separation may be penalized the same as speeding. Pit-Road will be CLOSED during a 'Code 35' incident. Drivers entering a closed Pit-Road will be penalized at the discretion of the Chief Steward. Any car on Pit-Road before a 'Code 35' begins may complete their pit-stop and re-enter the race. AUTHORITY: VIR Track Management.

**Vehicle Testing:**

No testing of vehicles or fast driving is allowed outside of designated areas such as the Grand, Full, North, South, and Patriot Courses and the Skidpad (as well as neighboring public roads). Violators will be expelled from the track without a refund.

**Fuel:**

VIR has an exclusive relationship with Sunoco Race Fuel. Track Renters and their participants shall not bring any other fuels into VIR for sale without prior written permission from VIR. **Track Renters shall ensure their Participants do not bring 55 gallon drums or other fuel containers on the VIR Property unless they are empty and used at the Property for filling with fuel purchased at VIR.** The only exception is Participants are permitted to bring up to 20 gallons of fuel in acceptable containers to the track without penalty. Credits cards are the only form of payment accepted at the fuel pumps in the North Paddock. **For full scoop on track fuel, visit <https://virnow.com/about/policies/fuel/>.**

**Asphalt Care:**

Pounding stakes or making holes in any asphalt surface or the use of paint or spray markings of any type on any asphalt surface, is prohibited. Offenders will be held liable for all damages and may be ejected and refused re-entry. VIR requests that anyone refueling in the paddock use a drip pan to catch spilled fuel. Any fuel spills on any paved surface must be immediately diluted with Cold Fire. Cold Fire can be obtained from EMS or Security Staff in the paddock. Immediate notification of fuel spills will not incur any fees for the application of Cold Fire. If you must temporarily raise a vehicle on asphalt or utilize landing gear with a trailer, you must have metal or wood under the jack and jack stands. NO EXCEPTIONS! Violators are subject to a \$500 fee per damaged/marked area. Receptacles for oil and coolant waste is available at the Tech Shed.

**Camping:**

**\*\*UPDATED\*\***

VIR allows camping in the paddock, including tents, RVs and [Premium RV](#) spaces (premium RV spaces must be reserved through the track). **BUT YOU MUST SECURE A PADDOCK PERMIT FOR EACH TRAILER/TRANSPORT VEHICLE/RV/TENT THAT IS USED FOR SLEEPING THROUGH LUCKY DOG for \$50 for the weekend via the Raceday Registration system or at Thursday's Registration.** **The paddock will be checked for your posted Paddock Permit.** This will allow teams to bypass having to get a permit from the track as you come through the front gate, [expediting Paddock move-in](#). Note that camping fees do not include access to electricity that must still be purchased from VIR; see below. Please review VIR's Camping Policies at <https://virnow.com/wp-content/uploads/2024/03/2024-Camping-Policy-Final.pdf>.

**Pit Lane & Paddock Power:**

Pit lane power is very limited; generators are recommended. Power must be reserved and paid through the track (\$40 for the weekend). Camping fees do not include access to electricity. VIR will issue an electrical "Power Band" this band is to be placed on the end of the electrical cord plugged into a VIR power source. Security will periodically check the power stations and will remove any power cord that does not have the proper power band. Contact the VIR office at 434-822-7700 Ext. 101.

**Rented RVs Deliver to Track:**

If you are contracting or renting a RV/Camper and it will be delivered by a third party you will need to fill out the [RV Camping Form](#), so it can be expected and directed to the correct location/reserved space RV/Campers being delivered by a third party must have the site reserved and paid for in advance.



**EVs & Charging:** The Electric Vehicle charging station in the Raceplex is the designated EV charging area. EVs are not permitted to charge at power poles or outlets located anywhere else on the property. Electric Bikes and scooters are not permitted inside lodge rooms or other VIR buildings at any time and are not permitted to be charged from a building outlet.

**Pit Vehicle Fee:** If you have an unlicensed pit, paddock, or other off-road vehicle (i.e., golf cart, pit bike, **scooter-seat required**, ATV, etc.), the track requires purchase of a permit (\$30 when purchased in advance and \$35 when purchased onsite) and this pass must be displayed on the vehicle at all times. - Drones:** At no time during the entire weekend (hot track or not), drones of any sort are not allowed to be flown at the track.

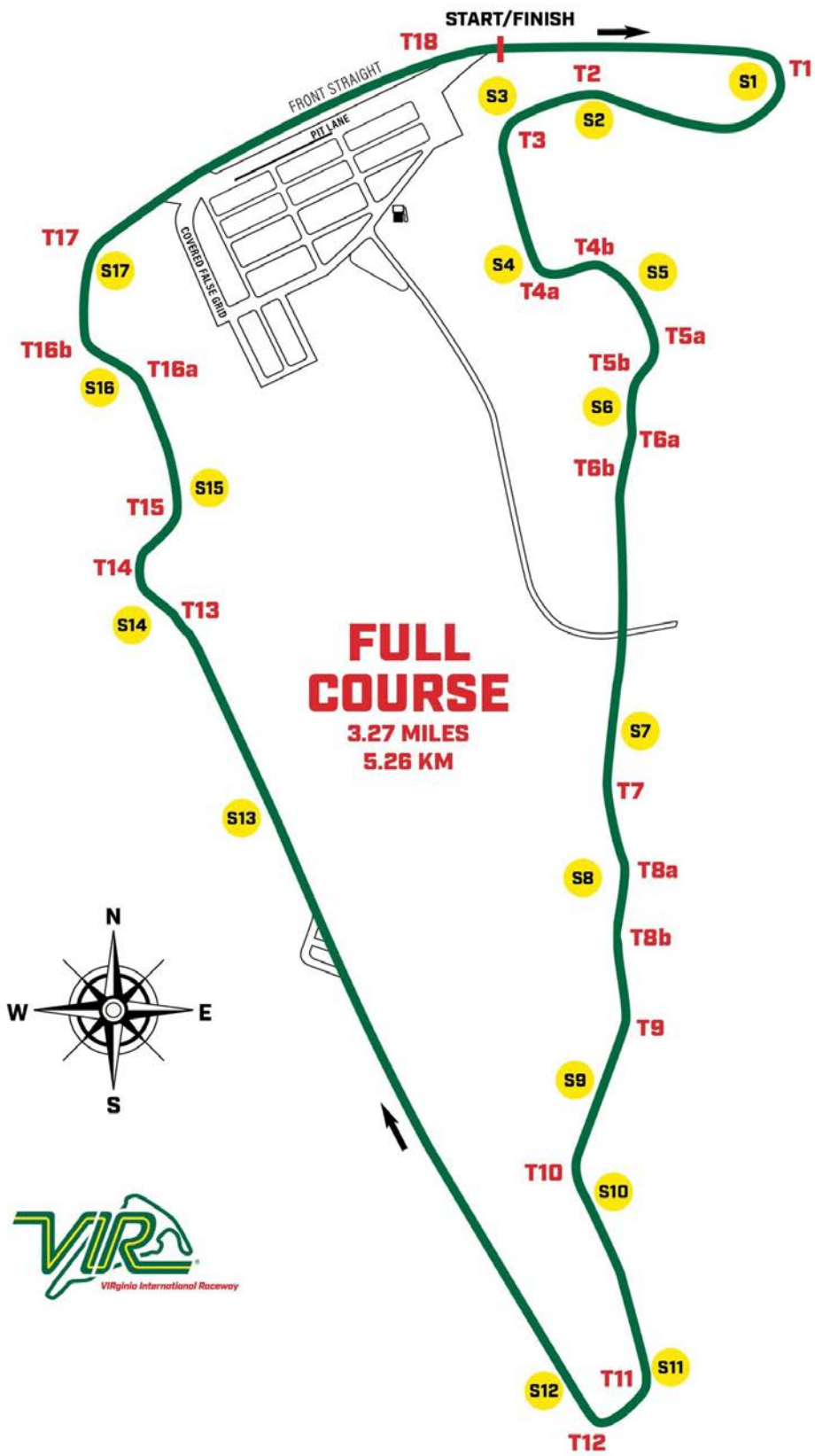

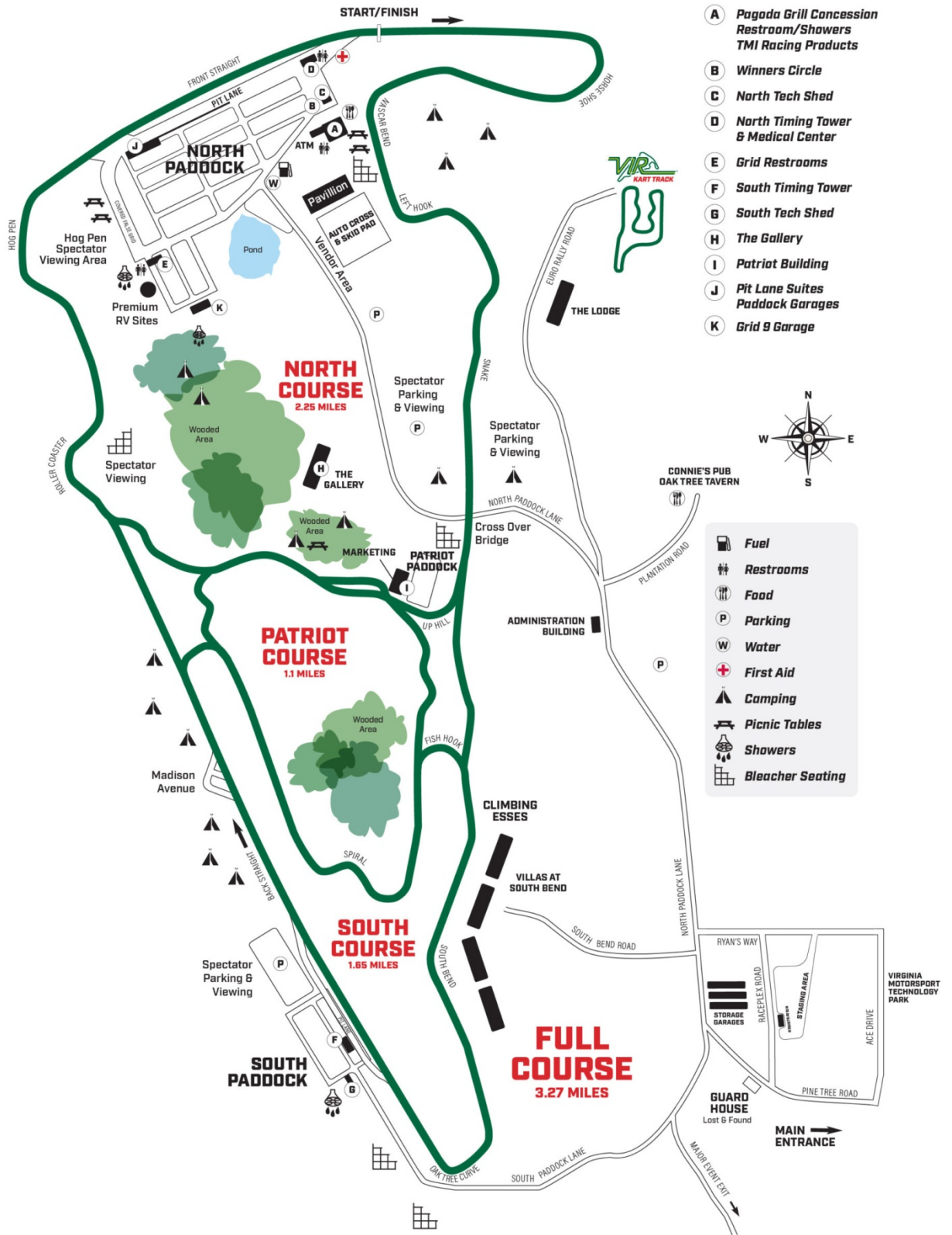

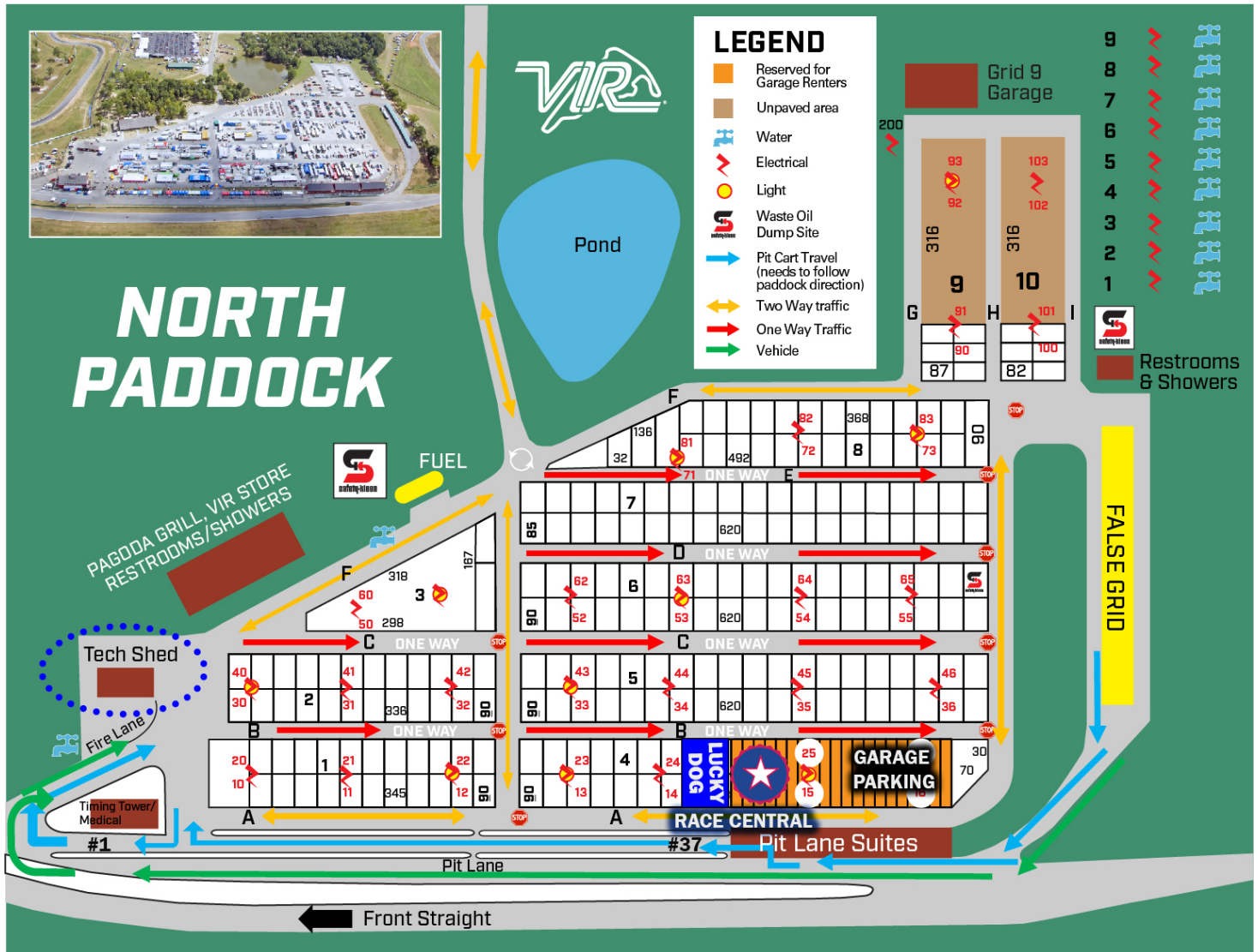
