Race ends at 5:00pm regardless of stoppages during the day; sunset is 4:48pm. Addi'll guidance regarding Parc Fermé (i.e., choosing to work on your car overnight vs. staying in position for Sunday's restart) further explained in detail below.

Parc Fermé Explained:

Parc fermé, literally meaning "closed park" in French, is how Lucky Dog manages a two-day cumulative race during a championship. Pit lane will close 15 minutes before Saturday's "black-flag all" 5:00pm checkered flag; CARS MAY NOT LEAVE OR ENTER PIT LANE AFTER 4:45pm. If you enter the pits of your own accord or due to mechanical failure, you cannot start the race until 20 minutes after the green flag on Sunday morning. If you're already in the pits/paddock, or need to pit after that point, you will start 20 minutes after the green flag on Sunday.

When the race ends at 5:00pm Saturday, teams still on-track will park their car on the front straight track wall adjacent to the track on pit lane (in order to preserve your track position)...BUT NOT IN YOUR PIT/PADDOCK STALL. At this point, all cars are parc fermé and cannot be touched or worked on for any reason including tire temps/pressure, cleaning windows/mirrors/lights, cooling shirt system servicing, fueling, etc. However, you will be allowed to cover your car for the night AND you may remove items that require charging such as your transponder, data telemetry & GoPro's.

If you have chosen to Parc fermé, you cannot work on your car or fuel on Sunday until you have resumed racing and have <u>taken at least one green flag lap</u>, and then return to your pit/paddock stall. If you have chosen to come into the pits/paddock on Saturday night to work on your car, you will be able to start Sunday's race after 20 minutes of green flag racing by your competitors. If your car becomes disabled on track in the last 15 minutes of Saturday's race and you are towed in, you may work on the car overnight and rejoin with the rest of pit lane 20 minutes after the green flag Sunday morning. If your car will not start Sunday morning on track, you will be towed in and can start racing 20 minutes after the green flag, provided you can fix it that fast.

The Ridge & Thunderhill for a number of vears), PADDOCK SPACES WILL NOT BE ASSIGNED: FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVE... yep, folks that plan to arrive on Thursday night will have first-pick of the litter. Please obey fire lanes or risk being moved. When setting up your paddock space, please be considerate of excessive use of RV awnings & canopies...we need to accommodate everyone. Extra passenger cars, guest rigs, trailers, transport vehicles, etc. need to be parked outside of the immediate paddock area as directed by the track management & LDRL staff. The paddock traffic pattern map is later in this document. PLEASE NOTE THAT PIT STOPS WILL BE 10 MINUTES (not the usual 5 minutes) to accommodate pitting in the paddock.

Camping/RV Spots:

Overnight paddock camping (self-contained, dry camping only, no hook-ups) on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights is allowed; \$50 weekend camping fee per camper/motorhome/trailer used for sleeping accommodations purchased through Lucky Dog during online Raceday Registration or at the track.

No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured barbeques and grills are permitted. NO SMUDGE POTS...PERIOD!

Alcohol/Drugs:

Alcohol not allowed during the race/hot track. And no glass allowed in paddock. Recreational drug usage is never allowed at LDRL or track venues regardless of local/state/federal governing laws; this is grounds for removal for the property. NO SMOKING/VAPING IN THE PADDOCK...or near fuel storage in the paddock.

Smoking/Vaping: Pit Vehicles:

Pit vehicles are allowed in the paddock (but not anywhere else on track or off pavement), and must obey the 10 mph paddock speed limit. No one under 16 allowed on any ATV, golf cart, motorized bike, scooter or skateboards. HELMETS

REQUIRED!

Track Walk:


People may walk or ride a bicycle (helmets required) on the track after hours with permission from track management. Nothing motorized; no scooters, golf cars, race cars, passenger vehicles or skateboards.

Drones:

During entire weekend (hot track or not), drones of any sort are not allowed to be flown at the track (per track & insurance regulations). Only FAA-licensed drones with

pre-approval from Lucky Dog & the track are allowed.
