**\*\*ALL TEAMS\*\***  
As a City park, and because the track is doing us a favor by allowing us in the night before our event, **a Paddock Access Permit is required for 1) any vehicle/trailer/racecar combo or racecar that is left in the paddock overnight on Friday, or 2), vehicle/trailer/RV that will be used for sleeping over the weekend.** Purchase a weekend paddock access permit for \$50 from Lucky Dog during online registration or at Friday's Tech & Registration. Permit must be displayed on your rig or risk getting ticketed. Paddock camping is first-come, first-serve. Self-contained RV camping (i.e., no hook-ups) in the paddock is allowed on Friday night after we gain entrance to the paddock as outlined in the event schedule move-in guidance. Tent camping is also allowed. **Hot pit lanes cannot be set-up until Saturday morning due to Friday night drags.**

This five-event points regional championship includes two events at the Ridge Motorsports Park, Portland Int'l Raceway (PIR), Sonoma Raceway & Oregon Raceway Park (ORP)! The Pacific Endurance Cup Champions will be crowned based on points so that ALL teams, regardless of class, have a chance to be a Top Dog! *The PEC Points Structure is outlined in detail at the back of this document.* **Teams are not required to participate in all four events and may race at single events, but those teams that participate in all four races (with the same car & at least two original drivers) will be in contention for the Pacific Endurance Cup championship.** Click [HERE](#) to learn more about Central Welding Supply's Lucky Dog FREE nitrogen program. ## OTHER EVENT DETAILS

**Track Access:** **REMINDER THAT THIS TRACK HAS AN INTERIOR PADDOCK AREA THAT IS NOT ACCESSIBLE BY VEHICLE FROM THE OUTSIDE DURING THE RACE** (i.e., while the track is hot). It is advisable that all teams park a service car outside the paddock near the footbridge, for all fuel runs\*, off-track services, parts & supply needs. **\*IMPORTANT: If you are carrying fuel jugs across the bridge, you must be accompanied by a team mate with a fire extinguisher; failure to do so will result in a dog house penalty.**

**Pit Lane Stalls/Paddock:** Pit stalls & paddock spots will not be assigned, but please be considerate of a team's paddock spot adjacent to their pit stalls. And to help conserve space, please limit the use of awnings & canopies. REMEMBER THAT THE PADDOCK IS ONE DIRECTION TRAFFIC; COUNTER CLOCKWISE. Paddock speed 10 mph & pit lane speed 25 mph; relentlessly enforced!

**Liability Waivers:** All people (drivers, guests, etc.) on property must sign the track liability form.

**Headlights:** Not required though handy in inclement weather. Sunset is at 8:54pm.

**Volunteers:** We'd love to have you! Volunteer at [info@RaceLucky.com](mailto:info@RaceLucky.com) and earn race entry credits! Come out and earn \$150 per day in race entry credits or choose \$100 per day in race entry credits PLUS overnight housing; (space permitting, double occupancy & 30 days advance notice advised). **Live Timing/Streaming:** Will be available from the Lucky Dog website at [www.RaceLucky.com](http://www.RaceLucky.com) or via a mobile device via Race Monitor, new app Red Mist or Mylaps SpeedHive. Also follow the race & teams LIVE on Facebook, YouTube and RaceCapture/Podium. **Pets:** Are allowed but must be on leash at all times.

**Children:** Must be 18 to be over the pit wall (i.e., hot pit lane), and must be 12 to be in the cold pit lane (cold side of the wall). Please keep an eye on kids at all times since the paddock area is considered "hot" and there is a lots of car traffic.

**\*NEW\* BREAKFAST:** As a veteran's fundraiser, Heroes Motorsports will be serving breakfast burritos & coffee since the track Café is not open until 11am for lunch. Support an awesome cause!

**Lunch Concessions:** The Motocross Café will be open on Saturday & Sunday for lunch only from 11am-3pm.

**Fuel:** Fuel will NOT be available at the track, so plan ahead. If you are carrying fuel jugs across the bridge at any time, you must have someone with a fire extinguisher accompany you OR YOU COULD RECEIVE A RACE PENALTY, NO EXCEPTIONS.

**Alcohol/Drugs:** Alcohol not allowed during the race/hot track. And no glass allowed in paddock. Recreational drug usage is never allowed at LDRL or track venues regardless of local/state/federal governing laws.

**Smoking/Vaping:** NO SMOKING/VAPING IN THE PADDOCK...or near fuel storage in the paddock.

**PADDOCK PERMIT/Camping:** As a City park, and because the track is doing us a favor by allowing us in the night before our event, **a Paddock Access Permit is required for 1) any vehicle/trailer/racecar combo or racecar that is left in the paddock overnight on Friday, or 2), vehicle/trailer/RV that will be used for sleeping over the weekend.** Purchase a weekend paddock access permit for \$50 from Lucky Dog during online registration or at Friday's Tech & Registration. Permit must be displayed on your rig or risk getting ticketed. Paddock camping is first-come, first-serve. Self-contained RV camping (i.e., no hook-ups) in the paddock is allowed on Friday night after we gain entrance to the paddock as outlined in the event schedule move-in guidance. Tent camping is also allowed. All teams must vacate the race facility by Sunday evening at 7:00pm.

**Radio Equipment Vendor:** We highly recommend series sponsor Shawn at [www.SampsonRacing.com](http://www.SampsonRacing.com) or 866.396.7231. Order in advance for shipment! They offer a 15% Lucky Dog discount!

**Race Gear Vendor:** We highly recommend series sponsor [Pyrotech](http://Pyrotech) that will be racing with us at PIR! Order early for delivery to the track. They also offer a Lucky Dog discount. Andy Collins from Armadillo Racing will also have his supply trailer there too!

**BBQs:** BBQs are allowed in the paddock area provided they are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 20' of the open flame and are located at least 30' from race cars & fuel sources.

**Pit Vehicles:** Pit vehicles are allowed in the paddock (but not anywhere else on track or off pavement), and must obey the 10 mph paddock speed limit. No one under 16 allowed on any ATV, golf cart, motorized bike, scooter or skateboards. And because this is a City park, helmet laws are enforced. Remember that the paddock is one-direction traffic; counter clockwise.



**Drones:** At no time during the entire weekend (hot track or not), drones of any sort are not allowed to be flown at the track...per track policy and LDRL's insurance carrier.

**Weather:** We're racing regardless of weather including track tornados though if we have extreme heat like a couple years ago, we will go to 1-hour driver stints (instead of our usual 2-hour stints). ☺

**Contingencies & Prizes:** As discussed in the Rules, Hankook awards over \$3,000 in tires per event week, both days and for Class A, B & C for those teams that are running RS4s purchased from Hankook Competition out of Austin, TX.

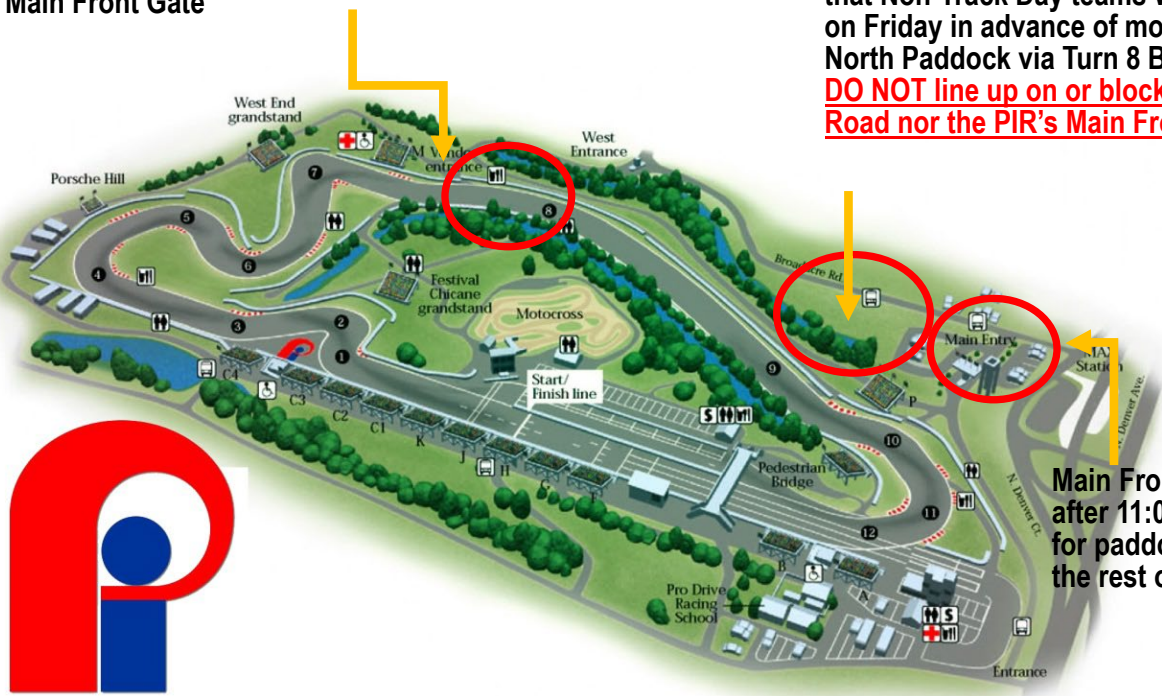
